Fourth General Meeting Alumni DKFZ Heidelberg including Alumni Heidelberg Life Science Lab

All interested scientists are cordially invited to participate in the fourth General Alumni Meeting to be held in the Communication Center of the DKZ on Friday and Saturday, June 18/19, 2010. This is the first time that the Alumni of the Life Science Lab are actively involved in the preparation and performance of this meeting.

The plenary sessions of the symposium are focussed on three topics, in which DKFZ-Alumni have made outstanding contributions: 1) Biology of Cancer Cells, 2) Infection and Cancer, and 3) Public Relations and Patient Information in Cancer. There will also be an opportunity to discuss a wide range of other topics related to cancer, namely signaling and RNAi, CD 95: a paradigm change, metabolic aberrations, molecular epidemiology, molecular imaging, and immunological aspects, with leading experts in smaller groups after the plenary sessions on both days of the meeting. The traditional Friday lecture of the Life Science Lab will this time be given in the frame of the Alumni meeting by Peter McLaughlin, Philosophical Institute, University of Heidelberg.

All Alumni of the DKFZ and of the Life Science Lab, and young DKFZ-scientists are invited to present their most recent results as posters which will be exhibited throughout the meeting (90 cm width x 120 cm height). The posters will be discussed after the plenary session on Friday afternoon. Three poster awards will be provided (300 Euro each, plus travel grants of 200 Euro for participants from European, and 300 Euro from countries outside of Europe).

On Saturday morning the General Assembly of the Alumni Association of the DKFZ will take place. At the same time, there will be an information on the Helmholtz Graduate School for Cancer for interested students. Very attractive social events are offered on Friday night and Saturday afternoon as detailed in the program.

Registration and Call for Abstracts

We ask all interested scientists who plan to participate in the Meeting to register by **June 1, 2010**, and those who intend to present posters to submit the title and a short abstract (about one page) by then as well. **Participation in the scientific and social program is free of registration fees. Food and drinks at the restaurant "Kohlhof" on Saturday afternoon are at expense of the participants.**
