This is without prejudice to the status of territories that came under Israeli administration after June 1967 and should not be construed as prejudicing Israel's principled position in this matter.

An Israeli PI may apply for funding under the framework of this program providing that a period of at least two years exists from the end of the last period funding as PI. This does not apply to the DKFZ partner.
