



Setting up eduroam on Windows end devices

1. Visit geteduroam.app and download the Windows version of the app.




2. Execute the downloaded `geteduroam.exe` and click `Connect to eduroam`.



3. Search for **DKFZ**, select the entry **Deutsches Krebsforschungszentrum (DKFZ)** and click **Continue**.
